## Workflow for holding a mass vaccination event during a measles response

This workflow covers the general steps and teams involved in holding a mass vaccination event as part of the measles response. Depending on the situation, the event may be very targeted and only offer vaccine to specific individuals, or it may be a public event to target a specific group or geographic region. Events open to the public will likely include more teams to coordinate public messaging and logistics. This workflow was developed by Seattle & King County Public Health and approved for publication June 28, 2024



(1) Immunization team works with
CHS mobile vaccination team and
also contracts with several
organizations to provide
vaccinations to individuals and
community events

(2) Request vaccine doses through the Childhood Vaccine Program (CVP) or Adult Vaccine Program (AVP)

(3) Mass vaccination event site would be identified in coordination with HMAC and/ or community partners (4) Vaccine inventory man by Immunization Team in Chinook building in space shared with Community H Services Division.

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(5) Immunization Team may be onsite or coordinate with the vaccine team remotely during the event depending on the situational needs.
